

## A PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honourable Sir Walter Benjamin Campbell, Companion of the Order of Australia, one of Her Majesty's Counsel learned in the law, Governor in and over the State of Queensland in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the powers in me vested by the *Officials in Parliament Act 1896-1988*, I, Sir Walter Benjamin Campbell, the Governor aforesaid, do, by this my Proclamation, declare that the following Officers of the Crown, being Officers liable to retire from Office on political grounds, are capable of being elected Members of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland and of sitting and voting therein, that is to say:—

- The Premier and Treasurer and Minister for State Development
- The Deputy Premier, Minister for Finance and Minister for Local Government
- The Minister for Health
- The Minister for Police and Minister for Employment, Training and Industrial Affairs
- The Minister for Land Management
- The Minister for Mines and Energy and Minister for Northern and Regional Development
- The Minister for Water Resources and Maritime Services
- The Attorney-General and Minister for Heritage and the Arts
- The Minister for Tourism and Minister for Environment, Conservation and Forestry
- The Minister for Works and Housing
- The Minister for Education, Youth, Sport and Recreation
- The Minister for Community Services and Minister for Emergency Services and Administrative Services
- The Minister for Industry, Small Business and Technology
- The Minister for Transport and Ethnic Affairs
- The Minister for Primary Industries
- The Minister for Main Roads and Racing
- The Minister for Justice and Minister for Corrective Services
- The Minister for Family Services

instead of the Officers, who, by a Proclamation dated the thirty-first day of August, 1989, were declared capable of being so elected and of so sitting and voting.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Government House, Brisbane, this twenty-fifth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and in the thirty-eighth year of Her Majesty's reign.
